On behalf of the Cree Human Resources Development, I would like to cordially invite you to participate as a Booth Exhibitor at the 11<sup>th</sup> annual Regional Career Fair, October 17 & 18, 2018 at the Gathering Place in Waskaganish.

The Regional Career Fair began from a need in the communities of Eeyou Ischee. The event provides opportunities for both job seekers and employers alike. Employers meet, inform and interview potential applicants, while job seekers/students get the chance to ask questions, talk up their skills and make connections. It gives high school students the opportunity to prepare for the workforce to see what types of jobs and fields of employment there are available to them once they graduate.

Students and job seekers will learn resume and cover letter writing as well as job interview skills.

Workshops will be offered throughout the 2-day event. Booth exhibitors (company representatives) at the career fair will inform participants of job openings and their hiring processes.

CHRD's Regional Career Fair takes place each year in one of the 10 Cree communities. A community is selected each year to host the event. The event is growing each year with over 500 participants in attendance and over 30 Booth Exhibitors. Companies such as Air Creebec, Stornoway Diamonds, Cree Nation Government, CBC North-Cree Media, CCQ, EnviroCree as well as educational institutions who provide information on post-secondary school programs.

Eeyou Istchee high school students will prepare in advance of the Regional Career Fair by working with their teachers and CHRD's Cree Employment Officers. Students will be asked to bring their resumes and to prepare to network with potential employers.
